

SWEET POINT SAMPLES

First thing you should do after purchasing is to make a backup of the samples, read this manual and work with the backup.

The tuning is chromatic.

The samples start independently of the actual octave tuning on the C1 MPC A-PAD and cover 4 octaves A-D PADs.

Check if the PAD Perform has the correct settings.

To do this, select your PAD A group.

Open the PAD Perform settings.

At the top, select chromatic.

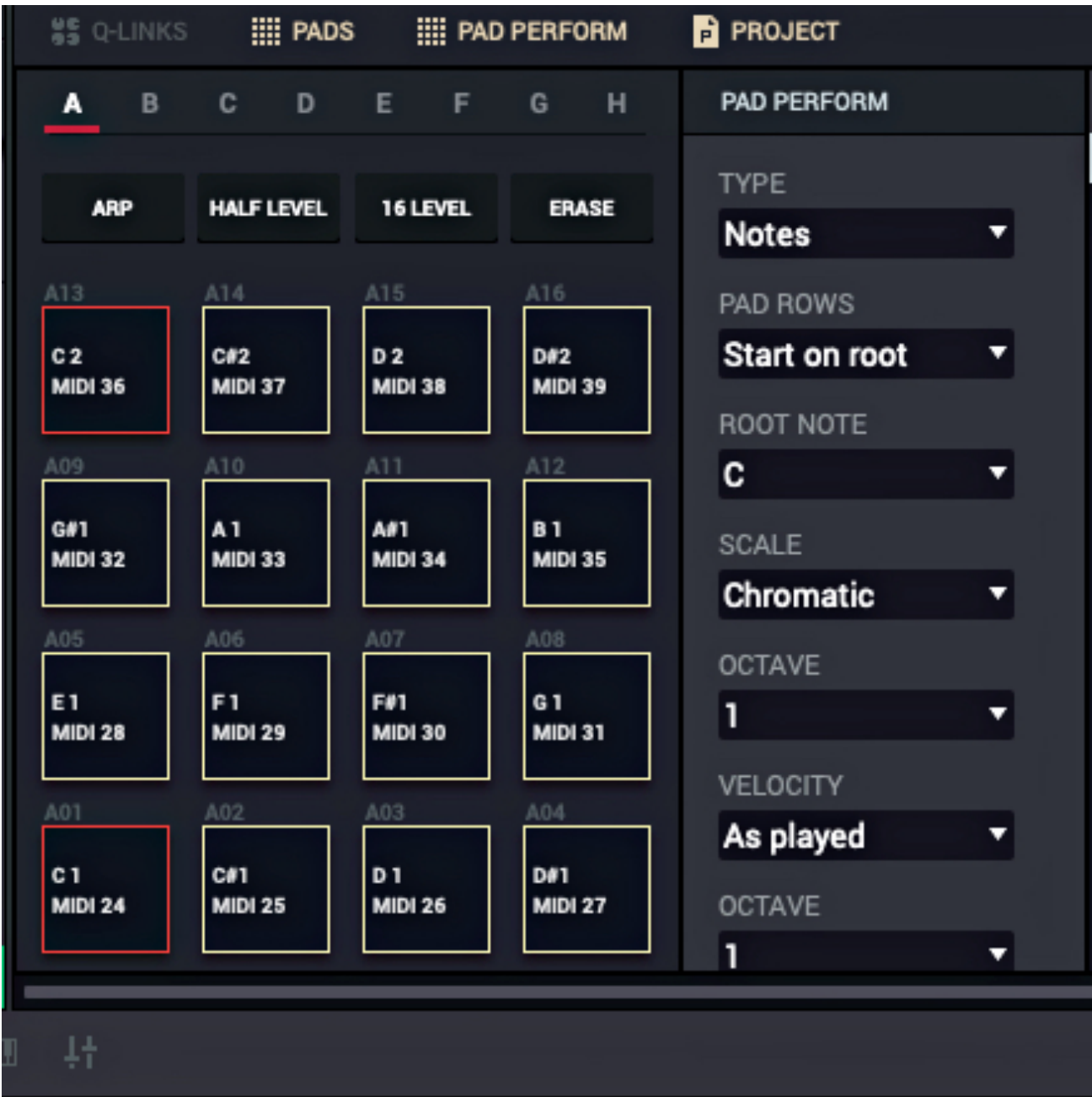
For Scale&Octave select C and chromatic.

Now select the correct Octave for PAD A , set C1 with the - + Octave control.

PAD A 01 starts with C1. PAD Perform should look like the photo below on your MPC hardware



Or should look like on the MPC software



To load a key program, select the MPC browser and the location of the samples.

Each sample folder contains a .xpm file with the same sample name.

Simply double click on the .xpm file
